Minutes:

- 1. SUMMARY: Accession Status can be set to "Active", "Inactive" or "Security Backup". Neha wants to track annual number of newly inactived, "historic," accessions. We already track annual number of newly incorporated "active" accessions.
 - Lisa B. proposes a trigger to add an accession action to document change of Accession Status and suggests creating methods to document the reason WHY the accession was inactivated. Inactivating an accession due to duplication is a WIN, inactivating due to inability to maintain is not.
 - Lisa T.: Documents with action. Commonly Record Keeping Errors or Failure to Maintain. Trigger is good.
 - o Benjamin or Kurt need to write the code for the trigger.
 - Benjamin: Trigger can only add the action. It cannot document method. The user must edit the new action to document WHY they were inactivated.
 - Stacey: Ames uses a fillable PDF to document "why" an accession should be inactivated. The completed form is uploaded as an accession attachment.
 - o GROUP: <u>Discuss and establish NPGS-wide methods documenting "WHY" an inactivation occurred.</u> Add to the accession action record.
 - o CCB VOTE: Unanimous approval to implement Trac #3087
- 2. SUMMARY: What was discussed at cooperator feedback meeting?
 - o Discussion was more about metrics than cooperator APR
 - Neha wants high level metrics reported as percentages
 - Focus on tracking collection metrics:
 - How metric changes over time (5-, 10-year basis)
 - Usage of a collection. Identify over- and under-utilized accessions (most requested? never requested?)
 - Accession status (Active vs. Inactive)
 - Collection availability: % unavailable?
 - Document "WHY" something went inactive or is unavailable to answer stakeholder questions. Inactivation due to duplication is a "win"
 - o Consider cooperator feedback from a "return on investment" perspective to document importance of the raw genetic resources of the NPGS collections.
